Kington House is a specialist residential service, supporting male adults with Mental Health needs and Acquired Brain Injuries, as well as individuals with Learning Disabilities, dual diagnoses and complex support requirements. Located in the heart of the Vale of Glamorgan, close to local amenities, parks and the coastline, the service provides a supportive environment where individuals can focus on rehabilitation, recovery and personal development.

Support at Kington House is centred around creating a warm and nurturing environment that empowers people to develop independence and achieve meaningful goals. Using tools such as the Goal Attainment Scale, Recovery Star and Active Support, the team works collaboratively with each individual to build confidence, regain skills and make measurable progress.

The service has particular expertise in supporting rehabilitation following acquired brain injuries, helping people move towards increasingly independent lifestyles.

The service is divided between the main house and a purpose-designed annex, offering a total of 11 en-suite bedrooms and accessible facilities to support individuals with more complex physical needs.

Combined with strong community links and a focus on personalised outcomes, Kington House provides a positive and encouraging environment where individuals can thrive and work towards greater independence.
