Through active support and tailored care planning, individuals are empowered to achieve positive outcomes and work towards their personal aspirations.

The service offers en-suite accommodation within a bungalow-style home, including opportunities for individuals to develop independent living skills through the use of kitchen facilities and personalised support.

With 24-hour staffing, supportive communal spaces and a strong focus on balancing safety with personal choice, The Paddocks provides a nurturing environment where people can thrive and build a brighter future.
