With access to psychiatry support and therapeutic groups, individuals are supported to manage their mental health and make meaningful progress in their lives.

The home offers a range of communal spaces, including kitchens, dining areas and gardens that encourage independence and social interaction.

Located in a rural village with access to nearby towns and transport links, Pathway House provides a balance of peaceful living and opportunities for community engagement, supporting individuals on their journey towards greater independence.
