The service offers a comfortable and sociable living environment, with a mix of en-suite and standard bedrooms alongside welcoming communal spaces for daily living. A shared kitchen, lounge areas and outdoor patio provide opportunities for socialising, relaxation and developing everyday skills, helping individuals feel at home while building the confidence to engage with the wider community and move towards greater independence.
