Chepstow House is a spacious residential service supporting up to 13 adults with learning disabilities sensory impairments mental health and physical needs. Situated within walking distance of the town centre and local amenities, the service offers a supportive environment where individuals can remain connected to their community while receiving personalised care.

Support at Chepstow House is centred around a person-led approach, with a strong focus on helping individuals achieve positive outcomes and reach their personal goals.

Through tailored support plans, key working sessions and dedicated one-to-one support, the team work alongside each person to build confidence, promote independence and encourage personal growth, using Positive Behavioural Support to create a consistent and supportive environment.

The home provides a spacious and inclusive living environment, with a range of bedrooms, accessible facilities and multiple communal areas for socialising and relaxation.

Combined with opportunities to access local leisure activities, healthcare services and community resources, Chepstow House offers a well-rounded setting where individuals can feel at home while developing independence and enjoying everyday life.
