Boston House is a specialist rehabilitation residential service in Oldham, supporting adults with complex needs following a brain injury. The service combines highly personalised rehabilitation programmes with specialist therapeutic support, providing a structured and brain injury-aware environment where individuals can rebuild skills, improve independence and work towards meaningful long-term outcomes.

Support at Boston House is delivered through a multidisciplinary, outcome-focused approach that recognises the unique impact of every brain injury. Individuals receive personalised rehabilitation plans tailored to their goals and needs, supported by a team of rehabilitation professionals including occupational therapists, physiotherapists, speech and language therapists, psychologists and behavioural specialists.

Regular reviews and measurable outcome tracking ensure progress is monitored and support evolves alongside each individual's recovery journey.

The service offers 11 en-suite bedrooms and six self-contained studio apartments, creating a flexible pathway that supports both rehabilitation and increasing independence. With access to specialist therapy services, communal living areas and

structured rehabilitation programmes, Boston House provides a therapeutic environment where individuals can develop practical, social, cognitive and vocational skills while preparing for greater independence and community participation.
