Conveniently situated close to local amenities, transport links and Manchester city centre, the service provides individuals with the opportunity to rebuild skills, develop confidence and become actively involved in their local community.

Support at Byron Lodge is centred around a personalised, outcome-focused approach that recognises the unique needs, strengths and aspirations of every individual. The team works closely with each person to create tailored support plans that promote independence, emotional wellbeing, social engagement and cognitive development.

Through regular reviews, measurable goal setting and ongoing collaboration with individuals and professionals, people are supported to make meaningful progress towards greater independence and improved quality of life.

The service offers 14 bedrooms, including 12 rooms with their own kitchen facilities, providing a flexible balance of independence and support. Alongside private accommodation, individuals have access to shared

communal spaces that encourage social interaction, relationship building and community living. With excellent local transport connections, nearby leisure opportunities and a supportive staff team.
