The team works closely with each individual to understand their experiences and aspirations, providing consistent and compassionate support.

Recovery-focused tools, including relapse prevention planning and the Recovery Star Model, are used to support individuals in managing their mental health, developing life skills and achieving meaningful progress.

The home offers a modern and comfortable environment, including en-suite bedrooms, communal living spaces and a self-contained studio apartment that supports progression towards independence.

With access to community opportunities and a setting designed to promote wellbeing, Ty Maes Rhos provides a supportive pathway for individuals to grow, recover and move forward in their lives.
