Chesterwood is a specialist acquired brain injury service located in Kings Heath, Birmingham, supporting up to five adults following an acquired brain injury. The service offers a focused and nurturing environment where individuals can rebuild skills, regain confidence and work towards greater independence, supported by a team with extensive experience in brain injury rehabilitation.

Support at Chesterwood is delivered through a personalised, holistic approach that recognises each person as an individual beyond their injury. Working closely with families, professionals and wider support networks, the team develops tailored plans that focus on cognitive development, social skills, emotional wellbeing and independence.

The service promotes meaningful participation in community life while providing a safe, structured environment where individuals can progress at their own pace and achieve their personal aspirations.

Chesterwood offers a combination of en-suite and standard bedrooms alongside welcoming communal spaces, including an open-plan lounge and dining area, conservatory and accessible garden. Situated close to local amenities, healthcare services

and transport links, the service provides opportunities for individuals to engage with their community, pursue interests and continue their rehabilitation journey within a supportive and encouraging setting
